




Typical Component Footing Detail

Installation Instructions


NOTE: Read installation instructions thoroughly before starting installation process.

Step 1: Lay out the area and prepare the site for install. Concrete must be installed over a solid, level base. Check local soil condition and local codes. See product installation instructions for minimum use zone requirements to ensure proper spacing and adequate surfacing area.

Step 2: Step 2: Dig the footings for the Spider Web Climber. The concrete should be flush with the ground level. Allow time for the concrete to completely cure before continuing. Refer to the typical footing in the installation instructions.

Step 3: Using an appropriate lull-type forklift or boom, place the posts into the footing holes. Unfurl net climber and be sure that the net fits taut between the posts before final mounting. See the the mounting detail below for information on how to attach the net to the posts. Plumb the posts keeping the net taught. Temporarily brace the posts.

Step 4: Pour your concrete per footing detail. Allow time for the concrete to completely cure before removing temporary bracing. Refer to the surfacing manufacturer for installation of an approved impact attenuating play
