





Installation Instructions

NOTE: Read installation instructions thoroughly before starting installation process.

Step 1: Lay out the area and prepare the site for install. Concrete must be installed over a solid, level base. Check local soil condition and codes. See product installation instructions for minimum use zone requirements to ensure proper spacing and adequate surfacing area.

- **Step 2:** Refer to the typical in-ground footing detail on excavating a hole for the slice.
- Step 3: Insert a 12" diameter Sonotube x 2'-7" in the excavated hole per footing detail.
- **Step 4:** Install 2 each 3/8"-16 x 6" (min.) J-Bolts (Supplied by others) into the threaded inserts on the underneath side of the slice.

Step 5: Pour concrete into the Sonotube. The concrete should be flush with the top of the Sonotube. While the concrete is still wet, insert the slice with J-Bolts into the concrete per footing detail. Allow time for the concrete to completely cure. Refer to the surfacing manufacturer for installation of an approved impact attenuating play surface around the slice a minimum of 6 feet in every direction.

NOTES PRIOR TO CONSTRUCTION:

- Use appropriate equipment to lift and move the play equipment.
- Check local codes and requirements prior to digging or installing any equipment.
